**81. 2006 Abbey Creek Riesling, \$20**  
Last year's trophy winner from the Qantas Show is an exceptional white: persistent, fine, with intense lemony flavours, balance and elegance. Well priced, too. See [www.greatsouthernwines.com.au](http://www.greatsouthernwines.com.au).

**82. 2007 Ad Hoc Hen & Chicken Chardonnay, \$20**  
A Pemberton chardonnay with intense grapefruit and ripe melony fruit. Its zesty acidity refreshes.

**83. 2007 Amberley Semillon Sauvignon Blanc, \$21.50**  
Deliciously different

from most Margaret River SSBs, this has pronounced green-bean and snow-pea flavours, is tight, lean and tangy, with a dry, zesty finish.

**84. 2006 Brokenwood Forest Edge Chardonnay, \$30**  
A fragrant chardonnay from Orange that impresses with its focused, pure, nectarine and grapefruit flavours, tightness and finesse.

Though youthful, this is pretty much as good as it gets from Margaret River or Australia. Restrained.

This has much more flavour than most pinot grigios, with a fragrantly floral nose with a great mouthfeel and a silky, dry finish.

Surprises and delights. This is big and viscous with creamy, honey, almost caramel flavours that persist. Limited quantities.

Victorian chardonnay that is clean, vibrant and succulent, with a fresh, dry finish.
