2010 WHISPERING HILL VINEYARD RIESLING

The Vintage: Outstanding vintage with fruit achieving maximum flavours and maturity.

The Winemaking: The parcels were picked and processed within 2 hours to ensure that the vibrancy and freshness of the fruit was retained. Free run and pressing fractions were separated. All the parcels were fermented using only natural yeasts, and batonage was carried out until bottling.

The Wine: Very pale, almost water like. Very soft palate with minerality, white flowers and some limey acidity for balance. Finely textured and elegant with intensity, balance and a gentle soft finish. Very pretty and delicate and immediately approachable.

Drink with: Fragrant and aromatic Thai and Vietnamese dishes.
