2015 Porongurup Riesling

THE VINTAGE:

Following on from an abundant winter and spring rainfall, the summer was nearly completely dry resulting in Porongurup and surrounding areas experiencing a fairly low yielding season, with most grape varieties achieving ripeness at relatively low sugar levels. Riesling lead the way as the standout variety of the Sub-region.

THE WINEMAKING:

The fruit was hand-harvested and grapes were gently de-stemmed. The free-run juice was fermented using natural yeasts, followed by a long, cool fermentation between 10-12°C .

THE WINE:

Pale quartz in colour, the bouquet has lime and apple with chalky minerality. Flavours of lime and chalky minerality follow suit on the pallet with spices and lime. The acidity is tight knit and long and the texture is soft.

DRINK WITH:

Grilled Sardines with spiked citrus and chilli slaw.
