THE VINTAGE:

High rainfall over winter followed by a very cool summer, with harvest being extended into mid-May. The dry, cool conditions helped yield some of the best Riesling, Shiraz and Cabernet seen in many years. Fruit thinning was essential and in some cases many passes were made to get the crop loads balanced but diligence and patience were rewarded.

THE WINEMAKING:

The fruit was hand-harvested at night and grapes were gently de-stemmed. The free-run juice was fermented using natural yeasts, followed by a nice long, cool fermentation between 10-12°C thus ensuring the essence of the fruit was captured.

THE WINE:

Bright tropical notes of apple, guava and passionfruit. Lemon drop freshness on the palate, undertones of grass and stone, white pepper.
