THE VINTAGE:

Low rainfall in winter and spring with some devastating frost events made the summer ripening season late. A tricky harvest to say the least but patience (and a bit of luck) paid off in the end with some exceptional wines being the ultimate result.

THE WINEMAKING:

Hand-picked and sorted the berries were gravity fed to small close fermenters where minimal additions were made. The wine slowly fermented with native yeast where it took 4 weeks to complete primary fermentation. The wine was matured in foudre for 12 months prior to bottling.

THE WINE:

Light bodied and fragrant, with savoury notes, strawberry, red cherry and pomegranate flavours on a very long palate.
